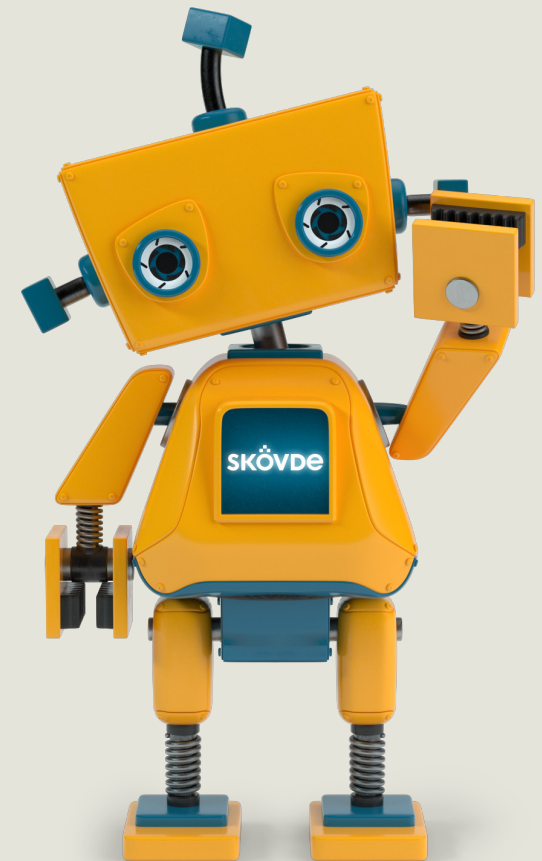

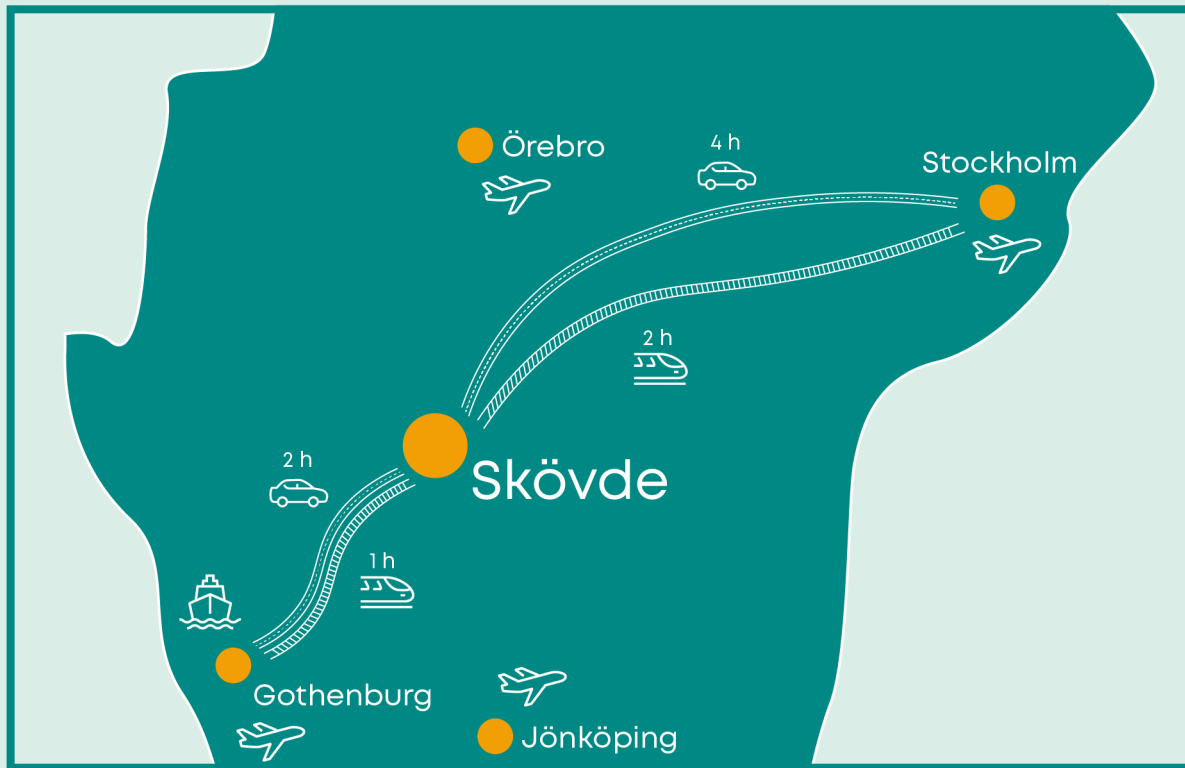

Play it like Skövde

Skövde is located in Skaraborg, one of the most industry-dense regions in the Nordics.

Skilled entrepreneurs have been manufacturing engines here since the early 1900s. The roots of automotive history in the region date back to 1868 when John G Grönvall founded a mechanical workshop and a foundry in Skövde. In 1925, Volvo founder Assar Gabrielsson sought an engine supplier for the first Volvo automobile. It was the beginning of a very successful era of engine production for Volvo and Aurobay in Skaraborg. Linking history to the future, the transformation has now begun to accelerate the journey toward a sustainable, net-zero future.

We have always been curious problem solvers who create our future by exploring possibilities, adapting, improving, and above all building people.

We are Sweden's largest labor market with about 300,000 inhabitants, where the dominant automotive sector employs about 5,000 people in Skövde alone. This has had a substantial impact on the people and the society in the region. A new battery cell factor

To meet the growing demand for electric heavy trucks and machinery, the Volvo Group has initiated the process to establish a factory for large-scale serial production of battery cells in Sweden. They conducted an evaluation of the best location both on a global and national level, before they decided on the Skaraborg region.

The Volvo Group's new foundry in Skövde

Volvo Group is investing 3 billion SEK in their new foundry in Skövde. A step towards a more sustainable manufacturing technology with reduced consumption of finite materials. The Skövde factory will also play a role as the group ramps up the serial production of battery packs.

New charging stations for heavy vehicles

Today, Skaraborg is an important hub for logistics and transportation. To maintain its central role in the future as the transport industry transitions, an infrastructure of charging stations for heavy vehicles is required. Skaraborg is accelerating the transition to a fossil-free and sustainable logistics system while simultaneously contributing to making Skaraborg even more competitive.

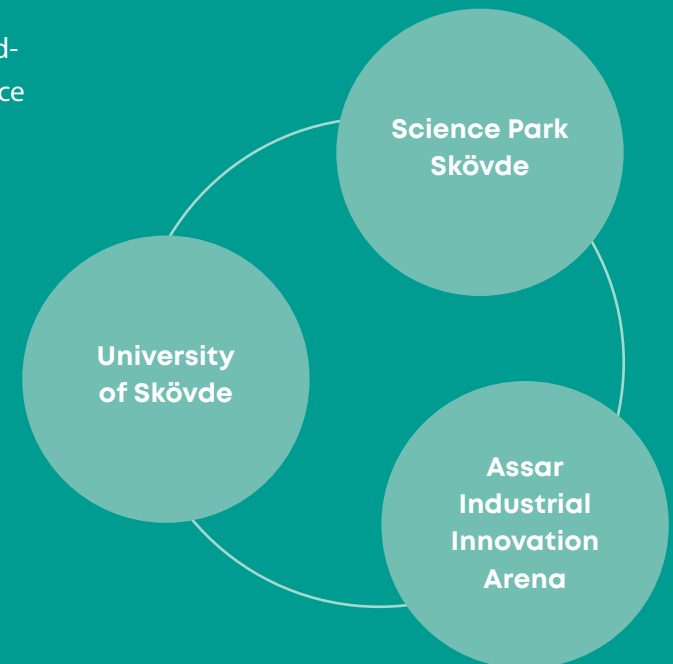

We prioritize sustainability!

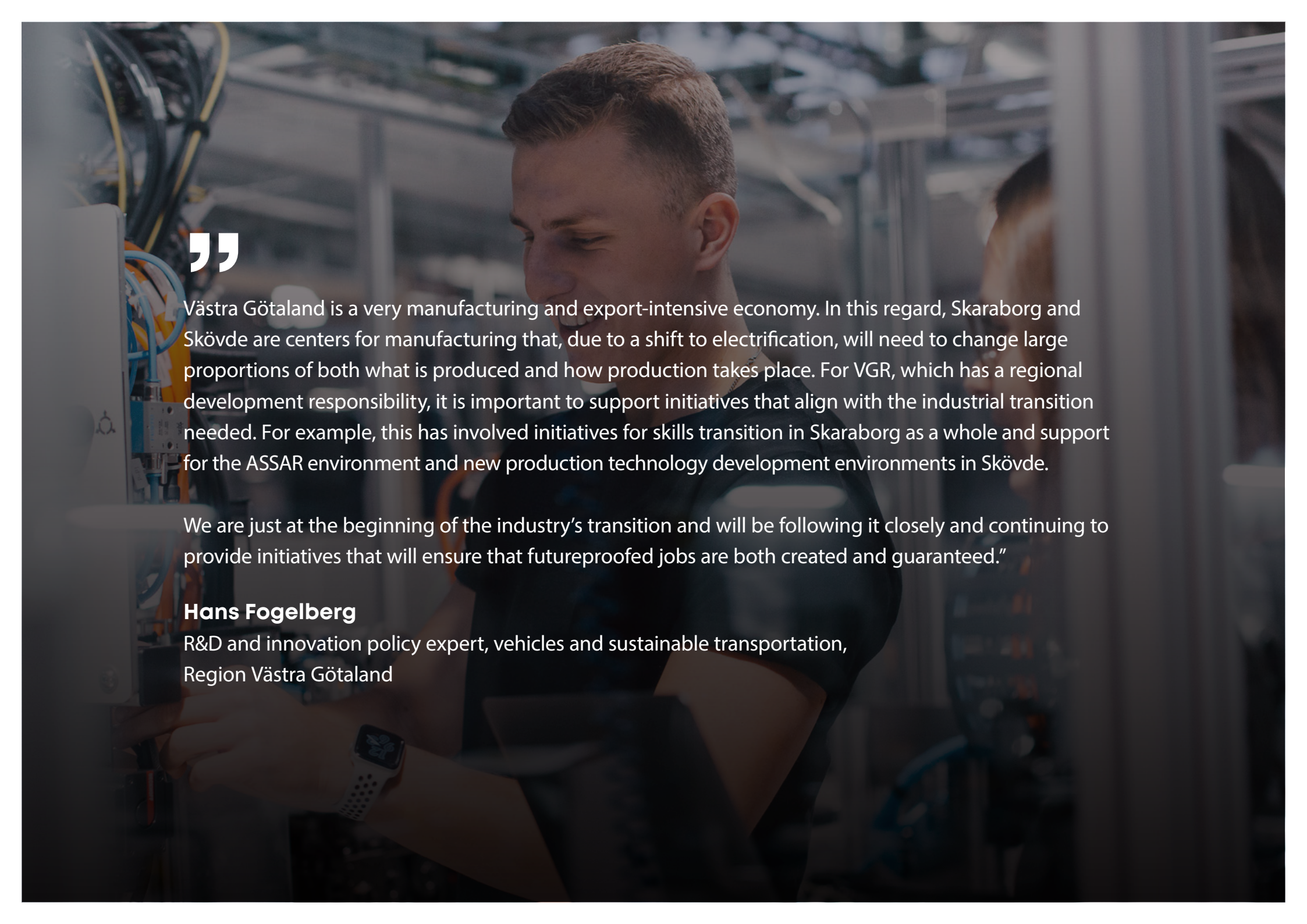
Sweden uses 99% CO2-free electricity, is ranked number one in the global Country Sustainability Index, and has among the lowest emissions per capita in the EU.

Västra Götaland is a very manufacturing and export-intensive economy. In this regard, Skaraborg and Skövde are centers for manufacturing that, due to a shift to electrification, will need to change large proportions of both what is produced and how production takes place. For VGR, which has a regional development responsibility, it is important to support initiatives that align with the industrial transition needed. For example, this has involved initiatives for skills transition in Skaraborg as a whole and support for the ASSAR environment and new production technology development environments in Skövde.

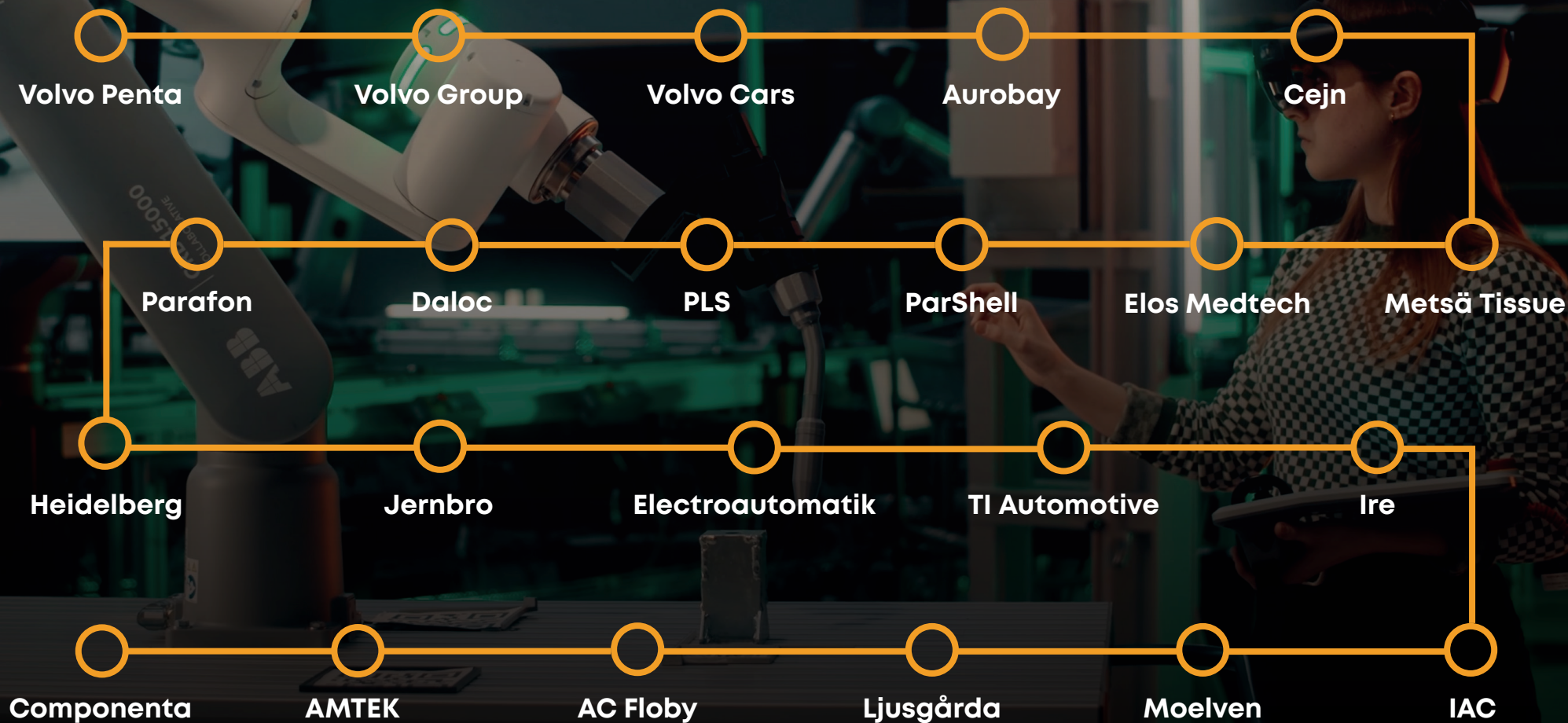
